



VINTAGE: 2020

VARIETAL: SHIRAZ

LABEL: ESTATE RANGE

VITICULTURE: Estate Grown - South Australia's Barossa Valley and Shiraz go hand-in-hand. It is one of the classic regional-varietal pairings in the world. Regular warm sunny days, with nights that are surprisingly cool for the uninitiated, ensure this moderate climate variety can ripen fully without losing too much natural acidity

VINIFICATION: No less than 22 Months Barrel maturation. Predominantly American oak 20% new.

ALC: 14.5%

CELLARING: May be enjoyed now or for up to seven years when stored under cool conditions.

TASTING NOTES: Rich and generous, with dark berry fruit/cassis aromas, rich mouth-coating flavours and tannins and a lingering freshness. Being a slightly cooler year than normal, the flavours of the 2020 Estate Shiraz lean more towards ripe damson plums with a soft pink pepper corn, spicy overlay. Restrained oak maturation highlights the fresh fruit flavours, while the soft acidity and ripe, rounded tannins cleanse the palate beautifully. lingering tannin structure.
